

Efthimios Bakarezos is an Associate Professor at the Hellenic Mediterranean University (HMU). He is the Dean of the School of Music and Optoacoustic Technologies, Director of the "Physical Acoustics and Optoacoustics Laboratory" of the Department of Music Technology and Acoustics, and member / principal investigator of the Institute of Plasma Physics and Lasers of the University Research Center of HMU. He holds a degree in Physics from the University of Crete, a Master's Degree and a Doctorate from the Department of Physics of Heriot-Watt University in the United Kingdom.
