

Nikolaos Stefanakis is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Music Technology and Acoustics of the Hellenic Mediterranean University and an affiliated researcher in Institute of Computer Science in FORTH. He received his Diploma degree in Mechanical Engineering from National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) and his Ph.D. degree from the School of Electrical and Computer Engineering of NTUA.
