This unprecedented research-creation proposes to collectively experience the interpretation of the complete piano works of Iannis Xenakis. The concert space immerses the spectators totally in augmented and interactive visuals generated by facial recognition, electromyography and motion capture correlated to the musical structure of the works. This augmented piano recital is shared with the Percussions de Strasbourg at the Center des Arts d'Enghien-les-Bains on November 24th at 7 pm.
